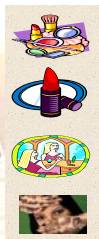

A lot has happened at the YCA since the last update. The YCA have successfully secured £72,000 from the Neighbourhood Renewal Fund for the provision of Adult Education. The funding has made it possible for the centre to run ESOL, ICT, Beauty, Mehndi, Sewing and Numeracy courses for the communities within the Sandwell area. Taster sessions will be held on Thursday 23rd and 30th November

YCA have also been involved in engaging 11 to 16 year old students into in to GCSE Arabic courses delivered at the Shireland Language College.

Arabic School has commenced in September and the parent governors are also in place.
